Performance Expectations and Admission Requirements:

Candidates pursuing a Bachelor's of Arts or Bachelor's of Fine Arts degree are eligible to apply to the 5-year Program once they have shown proof of the following pre-requisites, or an advisor approved plan to accomplish these requirements prior to transitioning into the Art Education Department and to the 5-year Program:

- 1) Thirty-six (36) hours of liberal studies, or, in the alternative, the equivalent of an Associate's of Arts (AA) degree from an accredited institution in Florida;
- 2) Intermediate level of foreign language competency;
- 3) Sixteen (16) semester hours of studio foundations;
- 4) Twenty-four (24) semester hours in art responding to the state certification requirements and art education program requirements; and
- 5) Nine (9) art history and criticism hours.

Candidates apply to be provisionally admitted to the 5-year program during the first semester of their junior year, while simultaneously applying and/or presenting proof of acceptance into the Teacher Education Program in the FSU College of Education in conjunction with a plan to complete nine (9) credit hours of the following courses which each constitute three (3) credit hours each: TSL 4324/ESOL, RED 4335 Teaching Reading, and SYO 4930 Sociology of Education.

Admission to the Art Education 4+1 Program further requires:

- 1) 3.0 overall grade point average (GPA);
- 2) 3.0 GPA in major courses in art (studio and art history);
- 3) 3.0 GPA in the required teacher education courses;
- 4) letter of intent;
- 5) portfolio of 10-12 artworks;
- 6) completed application form signed by their academic advisor;
- 7) successful completion of an interview with the Art Education faculty; and
- 8) passage of the FTCE General Knowledge Exam.

All certification courses in the FSU Department of Art Education are offered once a year at the graduate level. These courses must be taken in sequence.

Once accepted into the 5-year program, maintenance of an overall 3.0 GPA is required in art, art history, art education, and education courses as a prerequisite for Student Teaching (ARE 5940). Candidates must also pass all three (3) components of the FTCE and complete all certification course work prior to Student Teaching. The Student Teaching experience is considered the culmination of candidates' education and the most significant demonstration of her/his preparedness to teach art. Applications to student teaching will be completed once candidates

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have passed the first Professional Progress and Portfolio review during the spring semester of their senior year.
